

or the Committee. The uniform must be kept clean and in good repair and shall be delivered up to the Committee within seven days after request.

- 6 Any member neglecting or refusing to attend a fire or being absent from three consecutive drills of the Brigade without giving to the Chief Officer a satisfactory reason for his absence shall be liable to be fined One shilling and failing to pay the same shall be liable to be dismissed from the Brigade.
- 7 Any member wishing to leave the Brigade shall give fourteen clear days notice to the Chief Officer in writing and shall deliver up all articles of uniform belonging to the Brigade.
- 8 Any member leaving the Town for more than twenty four hours must inform the Chief Officer of the fact so as to explain his absence in case of a sudden call to a fire or test parade and in the event of the period of his absence being uncertain shall notify the Chief Officer of his return.
- 9 There shall be at least one drill per month the times of such drill to be decided by the Chief Officer but arranged as far as possible to suit the convenience of the majority.
- 10 When in uniform either at drills or fires all members must submit to the discipline of the Chief Officer and under no consideration take orders or instructions from any other person. The Committee shall have power to fine in a sum not exceeding one shilling or dismiss any member guilty of practical joking or unseemly conduct or language while at drills or other assemblies. Smoking is strictly prohibited at fires and upon parade.
