

Rules.

The following Rules were drawn up and approved and on the motion of M^r. A. Morris seconded by M^r. Bryan it was unanimously resolved to have them printed and circulated among the members of the Brigade.

Rules.

1. That the Brigade be called the Sawbridgeworth Fire Brigade.
2. The Brigade shall consist of a Chief Officer, Second Officer and seven firemen two of the firemen acting as Engineers. Persons entering the Brigade must be elected by the vote of a majority of members present at a General Meeting of the Brigade and should be recommended by the Chief Officer.
3. The internal business of the Brigade shall be conducted by a Committee consisting of the Chief Officer, Second Officer, and three or more other members of the Brigade together with a Treasurer and Secretary and one or more other persons who may be elected from outside the Brigade such members being elected annually at the General Meeting to be held on the 29th day of September or within seven days before or after that date.
4. The firemen's charges for expenses incurred at fires shall be made out by the Secretary and sent in to the Fire Engine Committee of the Parish Council. The charge for the use of the Engine shall be fixed by the said Fire Engine Committee.
5. Each member of the Brigade shall upon election attend three drills before being provided with uniform. The uniform shall be a Fireman's helmet and undress cap, tunic, hose, belt and case trousers and boots. These shall be deemed the property of the Committee and under no circumstances are they to be worn unless at a Fire or at drills without the special sanction of the Chief Officer.
