This was carried & the Hon Secretary was directed to approach Mr. Cory-Wright if the post became vacant.

It was arranged that Second Officer Hacey should carry on the work as Chief Officer pending a settlement of the matter.

It was then proposed by Fireman Horneell & seconded by Engineer Prior That in the event of Chief Officer Nockolds refusing to reconsider his decision he be offered a position as Honorary Chief Officer & this was carried unanimously.

Sub-Engineer Farling was then appointed to act as Temporary Second Officer to the acting Chief Officer (Mr. W. Hacey).

Resignation of Fireman S. Levey.
