Motor Fire Engine, Steam Fire Engine & Tractor.

This Meeting was called to go into the matter of the recent purchase of a second hand Dennis Motor Fire Engine & which had been offered by the Brigade to the Urban District Council for the sum of £210 the Brigade putting the same into good working order, painting same and making a contribution to the cost.

The Secretary stated that the Council had agreed to purchase the Engine on the terms mentioned and it was a matter for the Meeting to decide as to the amount the Brigade would contribute towards the purchase.

After the matter had been fully discussed it was resolved on the motion of Third Officer H. Taylor seconded by Fireman White.

That the Brigade make a contribution of £50 towards the cost of the Motor Fire Engine and a further contribution of £50 if the Urban Council will agree to hand over to the Brigade the present Steam Fire Engine and retain in commission the present Motor Tractor, the Steam Fire Engine to become the property of the Brigade.
