Additions & improvements to Equipment.

On the suggestion of the Captain it was resolved to ask the Urban Council to carry out the following additions & improvements to the Fire Brigade Equipment

- 1 A Block Spring on Engine to accommodate Breaching piece
2. Fish Hooks to be provided on front of Engine with proper Sway bars for same
3. Traces, hames & reins should be kept in the Engine house the reins being fitted with Snap hooks.
